David DiBenedetto is the senior vice president and editor in chief of *Garden & Gun*, where he oversees all content. During his tenure, the magazine has been nominated for seven National Magazine Awards, taking home the award for General Excellence in 2014. Previously he was the editor of *Salt Water Sportsman*, where he led the title to its first-ever National Magazine Award nomination (General Excellence). Prior to his time at *Salt Water Sportsman*, DiBenedetto was the deputy editor of *Field & Stream*. He began his career at *Men's Journal*.



Also an author, DiBenedetto wrote *On the Run: An Angler's Journey Down the Striper Coast* in 2003 (HarperCollins). His writing has appeared in *GQ*, *Rolling Stone*, and *Outdoor Life* and has been anthologized in *Best American Sports Writing*. He has overseen the publication of five *Garden & Gun* books: The *New York Times* best-selling titles *The Southerner's Handbook*, *Good Dog*, and *The Southerner's Cookbook*, and newer editions *S is for Southern* and *Southern Women*.

DiBenedetto was born and raised in Savannah, Georgia, and now resides in Charleston, South Carolina, with his wife, Jenny; their two children; and their dog, a Labrador retriever named Story.
